The Korlat solar power plant in Croatia will be constructed by Chinese companies SDEPCI and Norinco International. Its nameplate capacity would be 99 MW, with a grid connection of 75 MW. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) said it awarded the contract for the installation of.

The consortium of two Chinese companies has been selected for the construction and commissioning of the Korlat photovoltaic power plant, with the project set for completion by April 23, 2028. HEP has already secured a €31.6 million loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

The Korlat solar power plant, set to become operational in 2026, will be the largest solar facility in Croatia with an installed capacity of 99 MW. The project, valued at around 70 million euros, is expected to produce approximately 165 GWh of electricity annually, enough to supply about 50,000.

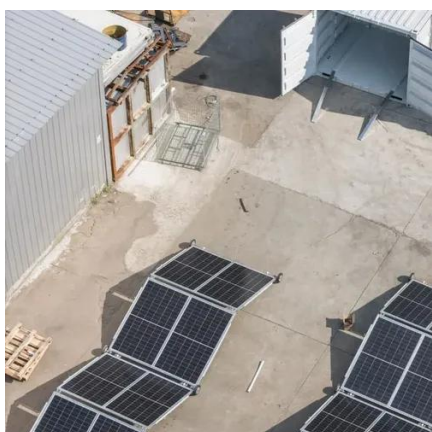
