Overview

Will China drop tariffs on imports from Africa?

China has said it is ready to drop the tariffs it charges on imports from all 53 African countries with which it has diplomatic relations. The move, announced at a China-Africa co-operation meeting, comes as the continent is facing the possibility of increased tariffs on its products entering the US.

Why is China scrapping tariffs?

By scrapping tariffs, China is signaling it got the message: it wants to “ welcome quality products from Africa ” and not just minerals if more African goods find a market in China, African economies benefit - and over time, that could reduce the trade gap and ease complaints about China profiting at Africa’s expense.

Will China's new zero-tariff policy rebalance African trade?

China's new zero-tariff policy for 53 African nations marks a significant step towards rebalancing trade. While boosting China's soft power, this alone won't transform African exports. Addressing non-tariff barriers and improving trade facilitation are crucial for unlocking the policy's full potential.

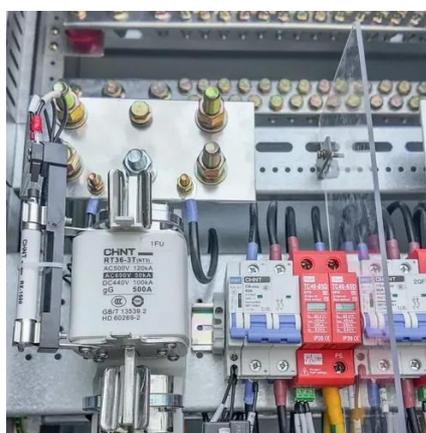


