Tigo is Guatemala's leading mobile player with 11.566 million subscriptions. In November 2021, Millicom, an international mobile and broadband service operator, that operates in Latin America via the Tigo brand, bought out the remaining 45% stake of Tigo Guatemala from Panama-based Miffin.

How many TV stations are there in Guatemala?

Television stations: 4 privately owned national terrestrial channels dominate TV broadcasting; multi-channel satellite and cable services are available (2007). Guatemala's incumbent telephone company is TELGUA, which won the bidding for the privatization of the government run GUATEL.

What is a telephone system in Guatemala?

Telephone system: fairly modern network centered in Guatemala City; connected to Central American Microwave System, a trunk microwave radio relay system that links the countries of Central America and Mexico with each other. Satellite earth stations: 1 Intelsat (Atlantic Ocean).

Does Guatemala have Internet filtering?

In 2011 the OpenNet Initiative reported no evidence of Internet filtering in Guatemala. Guatemala's constitution protects freedom of speech, freedom of the press, and individual privacy, however, government officials routinely violate these rights.

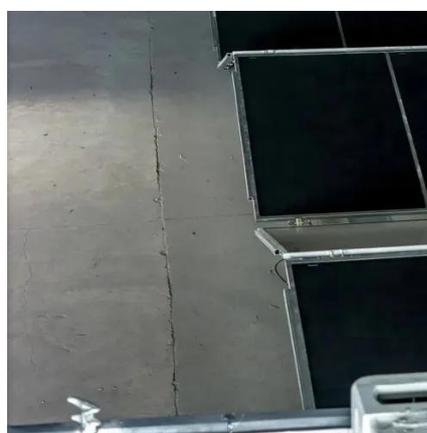

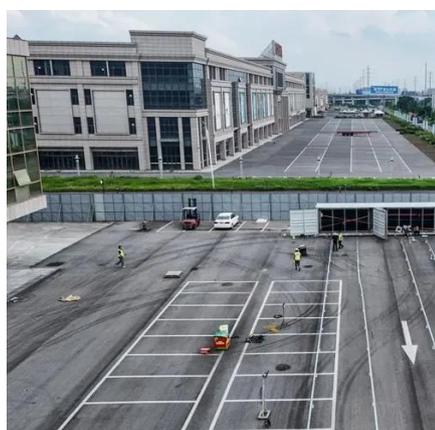
