In this story we explore an abandoned NATO radio communication station. Dating back to 1950s, ACE High (Allied Command Europe High-band) communication system used microwave radio to communicate over large distances, through 9 different NATO countries, from Norway to Turkey, stretching nearly.

This abandoned IDGZ station was one of 49 troposcatter stations in the NATO ACE High network. The North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Troposcatter Station IDGZ was a telecommunications station located on top of Dosso dei Galli in the Brescia Alps. The station, which operated from 1969 to.

The station was part of the Allied Command Europe Highband (ACE High), a NATO radiocommunication and early warning system that was operational between 1965 and 1995. This station is at 2,196 m (7,205 ft) on a mountain in the province of Bergamo. The station was one of a backbone of stations.

In order to maximize the distances between the main stations and to save costs, the stations would preferably be located on hills and mountains and be equipped with special “troposcatter” antenna systems. In 1958 a test network of four stations was set up in Norway, which was then expanded into the.

The last station in the network, which extends 8,300 route miles, from the northern tip of Arctic Norway to the eastern edge of Turkey, has now been accepted by Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe on behalf of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. This network has been brought into service.

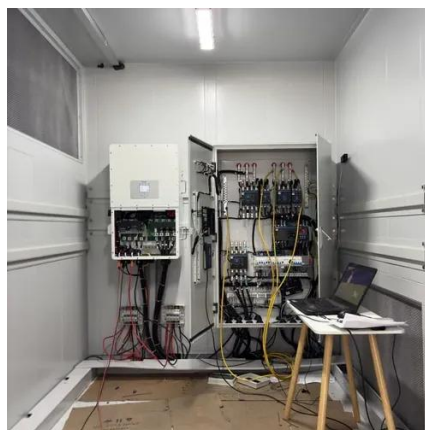

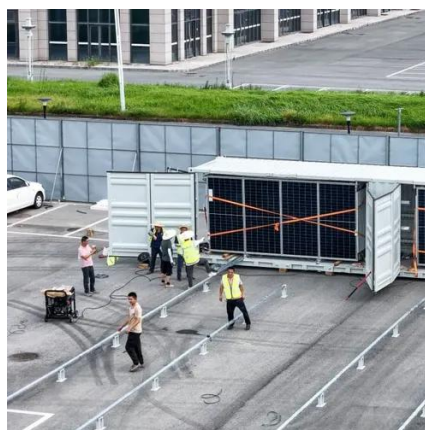
