Montenegro's state-owned power utility, EPCG, has canceled its €58 million tender for a 50 MW/200 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) due to the absence of bids. This setback comes as the country faces significant grid instability, exacerbated by blackouts and the shutdown of its largest.



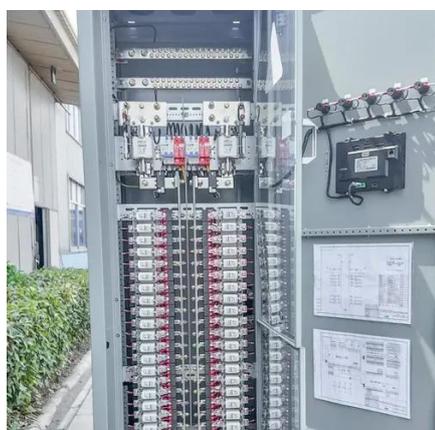
